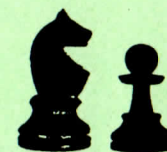

1. Formation of special interest groups in areas such as music, literature, computing and sport. 2. Assistance with the school/community gymnasium project. 3. A social committee.


PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE
