**CHESS School Tour** event was held on Thu Oct 24. Ex-students across many decades met & chatted about their school memories. Assistant principal & ex-student, Emmanuel Skoutas, explained how the current school operates & gave us an overview of the current student. A current year 10 student, Will, was also there answering questions about his experiences at the school.

Attendees got to see some of the teaching & activity hubs across the old & new school buildings. For those of us who were at the school several decades ago, the current library is on the upper level of the original building. The open student areas in some of the photos, are located on the upper floors of the 'new' building. With the school concert was starting at 7PM on the same evening, the school was abuzz with students & staff, preparing for the concert, with the familiar sound of school band instruments, as students warmed up. We hope to hold a similar event for members, again, next year.
